- Podcast Description (in 180 words)
- Podcast Language
- Format Outline
 - Category of podcast
 - No. of hosts (if any)
 - Episode Duration
 - Less than 5 mins
 - 5-15 mins
 - 15-30 mins
 - 30 mins and above
 - Estimated no. of episodes



- Ideas and/or titles of 5 episodes
- Target Audience (age, location, hobbies and interests)
- USPs: What would make this podcast stand out from other podcasts with similar themes or categories
- How would you promote this podcast? Suggest 3 ways.

Submit your work in a Microsoft word attachment (doc) to pitch@boundindia.com with a short bio (around 100 words). Please mention "Bound Magazine Submission" in the subject of the email.

Magazine Formats

We aim to respond to all submissions within 3 months. Please follow up via email if you don't hear back from us. If accepted, we may ask you to make minor editorial changes to your work before publishing.

Format	Particulars
Non-Fiction	 We accept pitches for opinion pieces, personal essays, travel stories, book and film reviews If you have completed pieces, then mail up to 2 of them (up to 1500 words each) in a single document
Poetry	 Mail up to 3 poems in a single word document Each poem should start on a new page of the document
Short Fiction	 Less than 3000 words (We might consider a longer story if it is exceptionally good)
Visual Art	 We publish illustrations, photographs, and anything else that is digitally printable Mail us in 3 illustrations in .jpeg or .png format



Additional Guidelines for the Magazine

- If we publish your piece, we ask for first publication and serial rights, but the copyright remains with the creator. Should your piece be published again in the future, please mention that it was first published here.
- We only consider simultaneous submissions or work that has been published elsewhere, including on personal blogs or social media platforms.
- We do not charge reading fees and cannot pay our contributors right now.
- We are looking for original ideas and pieces. Any instances of plagiarism will be publicly denounced and removed from our magazine.
- We will not consider submissions with offensive, racist, sexist, casteist, homophobic, violent or sexually graphic content.
- We value accuracy over everything else! Please proofread and factcheck (for non-fiction) your work before submitting.
